Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information, which your computer or mobile device downloads when you visit a website. Cookies provide visitors access to several functionalities. The information in the cookie can be used to track your internet usage. Under the Electronic Communications Act, all visitors to a website with cookies must have access to information stating that the website contains cookies and the purpose for which cookies are used. Visitors must also approve such cookies being used.

Drupal	has_js	Used to indicate whether or not the visitors browser has JavaScript enabled.	Functional	Once the browsing session ends

### Analytics Tools for the Website

On the websites stated above the web analytics tool Google Analytics is used to get an overall picture of how visitors use the site. Google Analytics uses cookies to collect information in an anonymous form (aggregated) about how visitors use the website, for example, the number of page views, how visitors have arrived at the website, and the number of visits. The purpose is to help us improve the usability of the website. The information generated through your website usage is

redirected to and stored by Google Inc. IP addresses are stored, but cannot be distinguished individually. Google can transfer the collected information to a third party if it is required by law or in case a third party processes the information on Google's account. Google cannot link IP addresses with other data held by Google.

### **Keep in mind**

(a) Cookies that are already on your device

Turning off one or more types of cookies will not delete any that have been downloaded in the past. We may still use data we collected up to that point, but will stop collecting new data.

(b) Managing cookies choices in your browser

You can turn off or delete cookies in your browser. If you do this, it may affect sites that use similar cookies to us.

### **How to control and delete cookies**

Cookies help you get the most out of our Website. However, you can set up your browser to delete or refuse some or all of them, or to be notified when you are sent a cookie and therefore, choose whether or not to accept it. You may also delete or refuse, some or all of the cookies, on our Website at any time.

Please remember, if you do delete some or all your cookies, some features on our Website, such as remembering your username, may not work and your experience on our Website may be affected. Unless you have adjusted your browser settings so that they will delete or refuse cookies, cookies will be issued or reissued when you log on to our Website. If you do decide to delete or refuse cookies but subsequently decide that you would in fact like to allow cookies, you should adjust your browser settings and continue using our Website. Cookies will then be sent to and from our Website.
